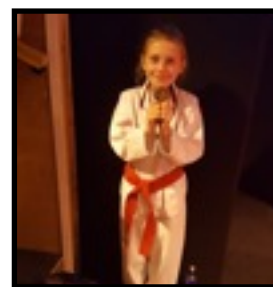
Congratulations to Ruby Potter (2AD) who achieved level 4 and 5 in her swimming lessons last week with Swims'cool', well done!
