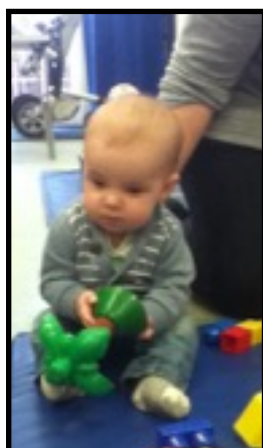
How to make your food donation
