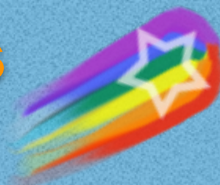




Churchtown Champions

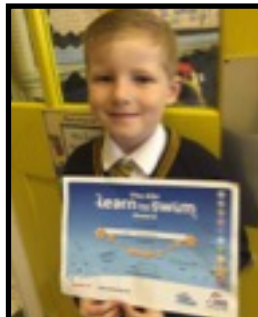
