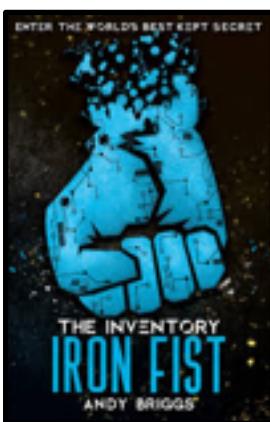
Visiting Author for Year 4 and 5
