This week, the children are participating in several activities to celebrate and show awareness for Behaviour Awareness Week 2016.

As a school, the children are taking part in various lessons and Circle Time activities to discuss what is meant by the term 'bullying' and how they should respond to positive and negative situations that arise inside and outside of school. They will then be helping to contribute to our new Anti-Bullying Policy, which will be uploaded onto the school website upon completion.

On Monday, the children were also visited by the Southport Schools' Worker Trust, who delivered assemblies across Key Stage 2. The children were very enthusiastic, taking part in different roleplay activities and dances.

On Wednesday, our Year 5 children were unexpectedly transported to the Victorian period where they had to experience the life of a Victorian child in school!

The children began the day by registering with their Victorian names and then sitting down for lessons on the 3 Rs (Reading, wRiting, aRithmetic). Throughout the day, they had to stand and recite facts, perform a drill in the hall and participate in an 'observed lesson' that involved Victorian artefacts. The children were able to witness what life would have been like for both poor and wealthy children, as well as what happened to any children who did not follow the rules!

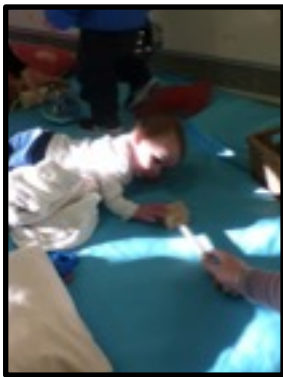
