SO LOVELY TO SEE EVERYONE RETURN TO SCHOOL

It has been lovely to see everyone returning to school yesterday and today. The children all looked very smart and they have been excited to catch up with their friends and begin to get to know their new class teachers. They have been working hard in class and enjoying listening to their new class novels.

We have a 'Return to School' document which is being sent out via parentapp, that explains in more detail what happens during the school day and what are the expectations for parents. We have been monitoring how the drop off and pick up has been going. There are obviously parts that we will continue to tweak and we will advise parents as these changes take place. We have noticed that more parents are walking to school which helps with the traffic congestion - Thank you 😊

Reminders:

1. Please ensure only **one person** is coming to pick up/ drop off their child from school.
2. Parents of children in Nursery to Year 3 - when you are collecting your child at the end of the day, please remember to practice social distancing as much as possible.
3. Please stay back from the doorways and allow children to come to you.
4. At the end of the day, children in Years 4, 5 and 6 can exit school from any gate.

Just To Clarify

Each day, children can only bring their packed lunch bag, their **book bag / small school bag / small rucksack** and a labelled water bottle into school. They must not bring any other resources/equipment/pencil cases into school. Children will be provided with any resources required.

We will be using these next few weeks to assess the children in a variety of ways and begin to cover gaps that we feel need addressing. We are having a focus on Reading and Oracy through class novels and guided reading lessons each day, as well as Maths following the White Rose Planning, which covers all areas that were missed last term. We will also continue to provide a broad and balanced curriculum.
