



Sun Protection



Now that summer is here and the weather seems to be getting warmer we wanted to remind everyone about providing sun protection for your child at school

- ☀ Children are allowed to bring in sunscreen on a daily basis, it must be the **roll on** type with an SPF of at least 30+ (recommended by the Sunsmart campaign by Cancer Research) so the children are able to apply it themselves prior to playtime/lunchtime. This should be labelled with the child's name and class and brought into school daily and kept in the child's tray or book bag.
- ☀ **For Nursery children we ask that parents apply all day suncream prior to the start of the school day.**
- ☀ Children are also allowed to bring in lip sunscreen to apply themselves; this once again should have a high SPF and should be labelled with the child's name and class.
- ☀ Children **will not** be allowed to share sunscreen because of hygiene and allergies and they will be expected to apply their own sunscreen
- ☀ Staff will use their judgement as to whether some pupils, for example, children in Reception, should be supervised when applying sunscreen
- ☀ If your child is allergic to sunscreen please notify the class teacher about this and parents/carers have the option of providing alternative methods of protection for their child
- ☀ We have shaded areas in all playgrounds that children have access to during playtimes and lunchtimes and parents may use whilst waiting to collect their children
- ☀ We encourage children to wear sun hats, ideally broad brimmed, legionnaire style hats without cords that cover the face, ears and neck
- ☀ we also allow children to wear sunglasses during outdoor sessions, which should meet with ultraviolet standards and be plastic
