As a school we raised a brilliant £622

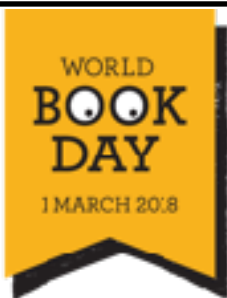
This money will go together with all the money from the other 25 schools in the Southport Learning Partnership to make a real difference to The Alzheimers Society
