

Our theme next term

is...

‘Sowing and Growing’

During the next half term, the children will be learning all about the lifecycles of plants and humans. We will focus on how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants and find out how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy. We will also study animals, including humans, and how they have offspring which grew into adults. We will discuss the basic needs of animals and humans and the importance of exercise and having a healthy lifestyle.

In English we will focus on writing stamina and writing to excite the reader. Our book study will be Roald Dahl's 'Matilda.'

In Maths we will be focusing on the number system, time, fractions, money and capacity.
